Findings

About 50- 52% of young people use the social platforms per day and about 72% of this number use there cellphones. 22% -25% of the youths uses the social media more than 10 times a day. The first finding was that young people are at a higher risk of cyber bullying. Most of the users of social sites have heard about cyber bullying but they do not have enough information on how it happens and how one can protect themselves. This lack of information among youths and teenagers makes them an easier target for the predators.

The second finding is that most youths are at risk of being exposed to pornography and adults contents.
